Dry Creek, Zinfandel, Sonoma County 2007

Zesty and easy to drink, with spicy cherry aromas and lively flavors of wild berry, fresh pepper and sage.

Barnett Vineyards, Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley 2008

Soft and elegant, this wine is filled with spicy cherry, white pepper and floral aromas with a vibrant spine of acidity.

Deerfield, Merlot Cuvee, North Coast 2004

Deerfield, Super T-Rex, North Coast 2002

Super T-Rex is a Meritage style wine with an Italian bent. It has the forward fruitiness and lovely characteristics of a Sangiovese with the depth and complexity of a Meritage blend.

Deerfield, Cabernet Sauvignon, North Coast 2004

The Cabernet finish is long, the Merlot front-end is luscious and the Cabernet Franc is just what you are looking for - the sensation of the best dark chocolate with hints of allspice and dried vanilla bean.

Caymus, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 2007

Ripe and fleshy, with rich plum, wild berry, spice and savory herb notes that are complex, full-bodied and expansive on the palate, ending with firm tannins and a dash of espresso.

Merryvale, Profile, Napa Valley 2006

Aromas of cassis, raspberry, perfume and vanilla are interwoven with tobacco, cedar and cocoa. On the palate the wine is dense and concentrated with a finish that is long and complex.

Dessert Wine

Gold, Deerfield Ranch 2000

The nose fills your head with lush aromas of ripe apricots, dried peaches and tropical flowers. The taste is exotic, sweet though not cloying, like dried apricots over Cream Brulée.
